COVID 19 UPDATE

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you all enjoyed half term with your family. Now we have returned to school with some of the **Covid 19** restrictions lifted we wanted to share with you how they affect the Fallings Park Community.

Advice to those with Symptoms.

Anyone with a new onset of the main symptoms of Covid 19 (continuous cough, loss of taste and smell and high temperature) should order a PCR test. They are advised to stay at home and avoid contact with others whilst waiting for their test result.

Please send the message of the positive PCR test to school as we still need to record cases.

Remote Learning will be available to all pupils who have a positive PCR test.

There is no longer a legal requirement for people with Covid 19 infection to self-isolate. However, if a family member has any of the main symptoms or a positive test result the **public health advice** is to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 days, and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received 2 negative test results on consecutive days.

Attending School.

Children who attend school and who live with someone who has Covid 19 should continue to attend the school as normal.

The school risk assessment has been reviewed. This will still include regular handwashing for all pupils and the ventilation of classrooms.

If as a community, we see rises in Covid cases contingency plans will be put in place immediately to keep us all safe.

We look forward to seeing you all in school soon and thank you all for supporting our school.
